Executive Member - Social Services

To have strategic and policy responsibility for all functions within the remit of the Executive which relate to Social Services functions. This includes, but not exclusively, the Executive matters dealt with by the Social Services Department, but may also include other matters from time to time.

Executive Member – Housing
