### 5. Largest Welshcake

Must be round, measured across it's diameter.

### 6. 3 Lovespoon shaped Welshcakes

The lovespoons can be one piece or several individual cakes joined together.

- All sorts of Fairtrade sugars are widely available at supermarkets and specialist retailers.
   Fairtrade honey and molasses are also available.
- Fairtrade chocolate comes in a variety of flavours and can be found in supermarkets especially Co-op, Aldi and Lidl.
- Fairtrade Jams and marmalades and nut butters can be found in some supermarkets including M&S and specialist shops.
- Dried fruit, nuts and spices can be found in specialist shops and some supermarkets.
- Dried fruit can be pre-soaked in Fairtrade fruit juices, teas, coffees or rum.
