DATGANIAD O'R RHESYMAU

Mae Cyngor Blaenau Gwent wedi derbyn cais gan aelod etholedig lleol i aolygu trefniadau traffig o fewn Stad Hafodarthlen.

Mae Stad Hafodarthlen yn cynnwys stryd drefol gymharol gul sydd ar hyn o bryd yn gweithredu gyda thraffig dwyffordd, gyda'r ffordd allan ac i mewn trwy Stad Mount Pleasant.

Ailsefydlwyd y gyffordd â Stad Mount Pleasant yn y gogledd-ddwyrain yn ddiweddar yn dilyn pryderon gan drigolion ynghylch diffyg lle i gerbydau mwy droi.

Ystyrir bellach y byddai cyflwyno system draffig unffordd yn gwella diogelwch ar y ffordd trwy leihau gwrthdaro rhwng cerbydau, gwella'r llif traffig yn gyffredinol, ac atal difrod i adeiladau.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Blaenau Gwent Council has received a request from a local elected member to review traffic arrangements within Hafodarthlen Estate.

Hafodarthlen Estate comprises a relatively narrow urban street currently operating with two-way traffic, providing both entry and exit via Mount Pleasant Estate.

The north-east junction with Mount Pleasant Estate was recently reinstated following concerns from residents regarding insufficient space for larger vehicles to complete turning manoeuvres.

It is now considered that introducing a one-way traffic system would enhance road safety by reducing vehicle conflicts, improving overall traffic flow and preventing damage to buildings.
