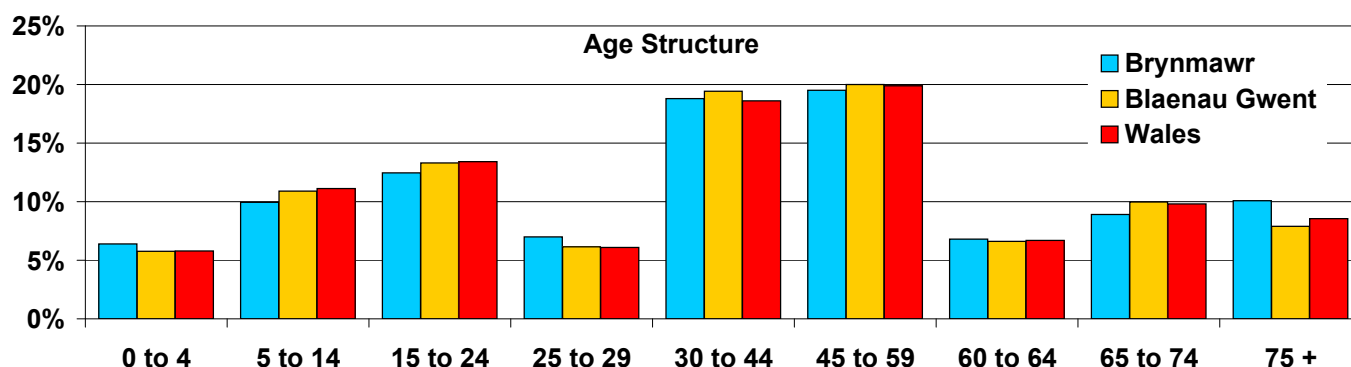

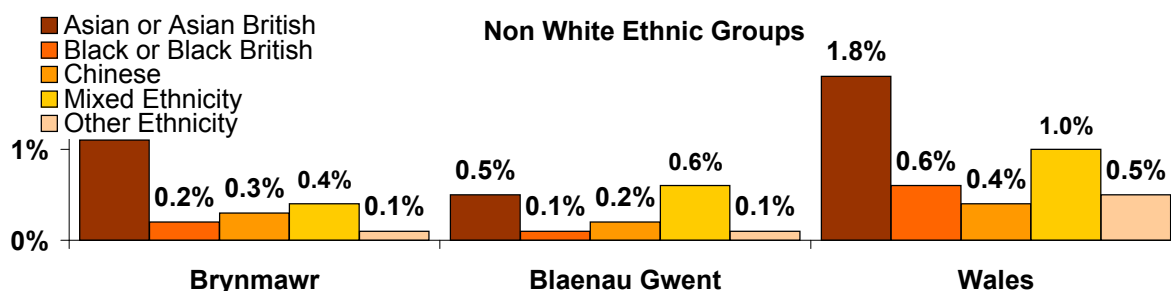

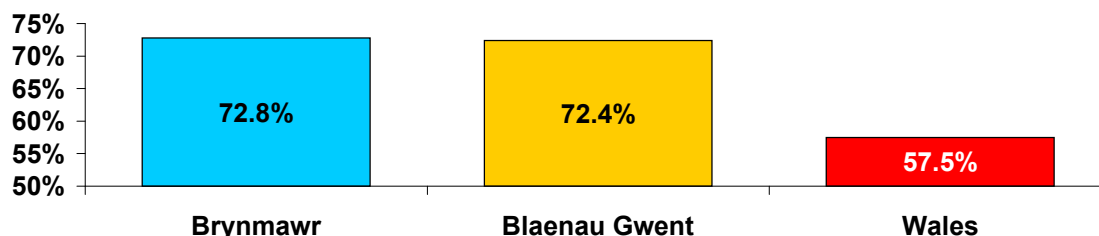

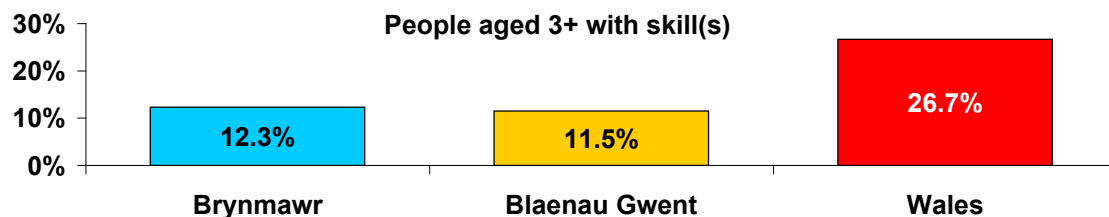

People indentifying as Welsh only

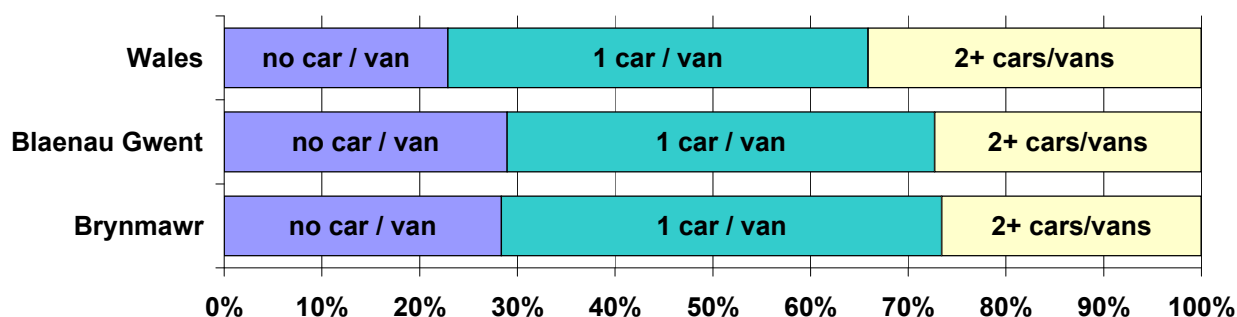

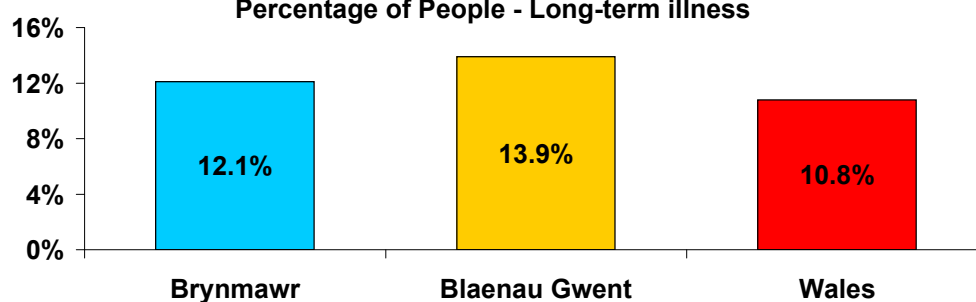

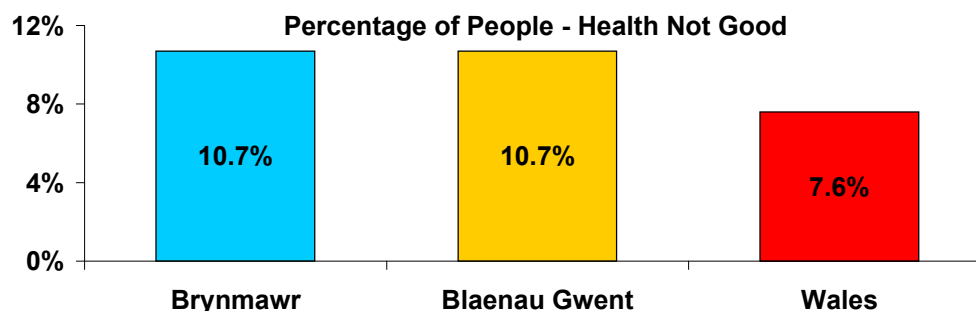

Percentage of People - Long-term illness

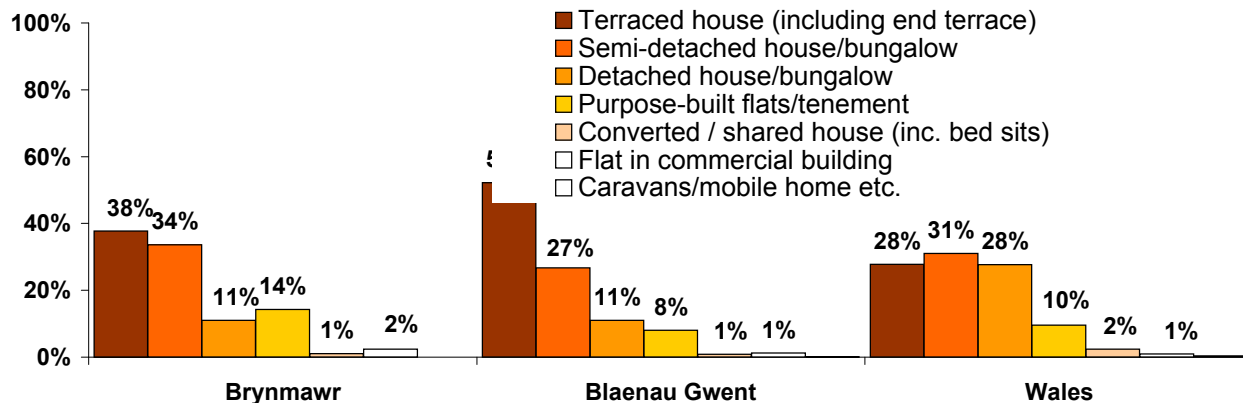


Percentage of People - Health Not Good

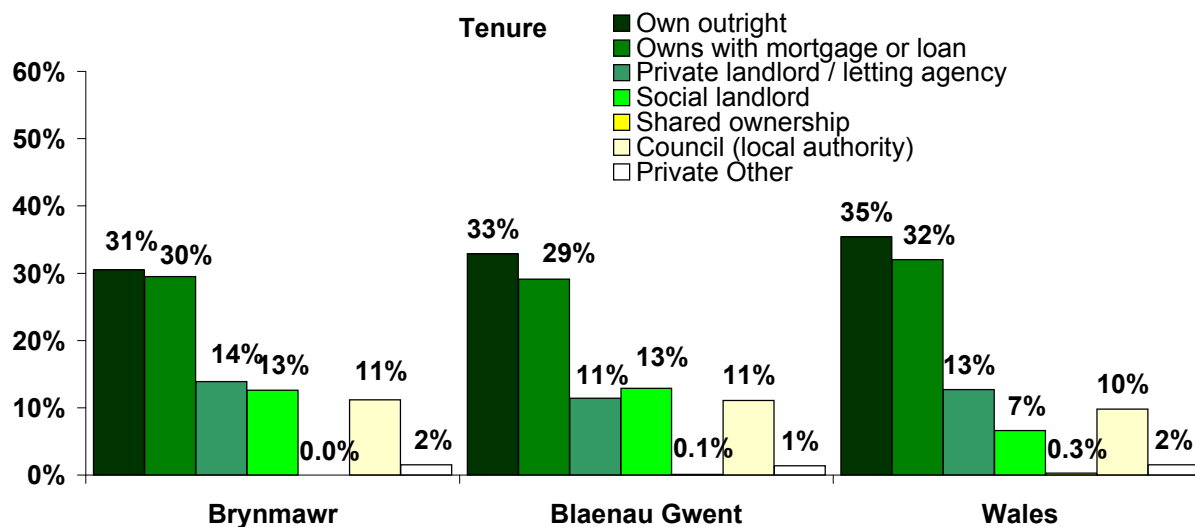

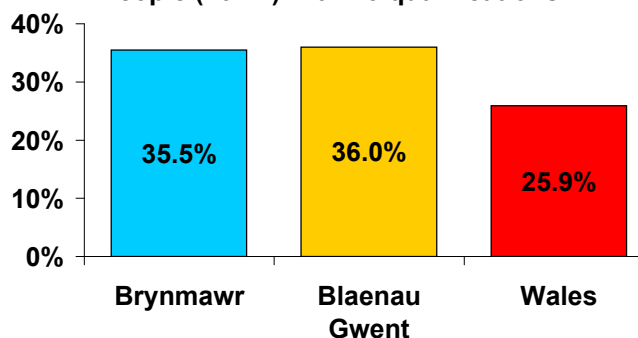
