# **Eligible Expenditure**

- Rent
- Wages
- Heating & Lighting
- Marketing
- Resources/Equipment
- Small kitchen appliances
- Crockery
- Purchased via cheque, debit card or online BACS payment



#### **Ineligible Expenditure**

- Expenditure incurred **BEFORE** the date the Grant is offered
- Repair & maintenance
- Revenue costs
- Membership payments
- Legal & professional fees
- HP / Lease Hire purchases
- Cash or Credit Card purchases

#### **Application Process**

- Must be registered with Blaenau Gwent Family Information Service
- Application Form accompanied by:
  - 1. A Copy of Statement of Purpose
  - 2. Commitment to undertake the Blaenau Gwent Quality Improvement Scheme 2016/17

#### When can you apply?
